COVID-19 catch-up premium spending: summary

The 16 to 19 tuition fund is to enable schools, colleges and all other 16 to 19 providers to mitigate the disruption to learning arising from coronavirus (COVID-19).

Covid 19 Catch-Up funding 2021-22 is being used in the following ways:

- To support small group or 1:1 tuition delivered by our own staff in GCSE English and/or Maths where students have not reached Grade 4 or where students wish to improve their grades from 4 to 5.
- To support students wishing to re-take any other GCSE subjects to improve their grades.
- Through the provision of revision materials either online or in book format or, in cases where students do not have access to appropriate technology during periods of isolation or lockdown, a laptop.
- To support identified students in both years 12 & 13 who are not making expected progress in one or more of their Level 3 programmes of study. Additional support will be provided through small group teaching, revision, provision of additional learning resources and catch up sessions. Initial support provided within curriculum time, followed by additional catch-up sessions outside of contact time and through use of external agencies for targeted students eg My Tutor.
- Through the provision of additional revision materials/guides not funded by departmental capitation.
- Through the provision of a revision and study skills conference for all Y13 students so that they are prepared for external examinations.
